INTRODUCTION

The Highpointers Club offers a scholarship program for family members of the Highpointers Club to support and celebrate the education of our youth. In accordance with the Highpointers mission, we offer this annual scholarship as part of a program that fosters education, youth participation, in outdoor activities and environmental awareness.

What

A \$500 college scholarship will be awarded to one person each calendar year. The process will begin with a Call for Applications in April and conclude with an Award during the Highpointers Annual Convention. The award is meant to assist with school expenses such as tuition, books or living expenses. The winning applicant is encouraged, but is not required to attend the Convention.

How

The marketing, application, communication and award processes will be managed by the Highpointers Club Marketing Committee and will follow these guidelines:

1. Eligible students complete an application. Application is scored based on education and activities provided.
2. Application must include the submission of a 1 to 3 page, single-spaced original essay (~ 2,000 words).
3. Essay will be judged by a 3-person committee, based on the following criteria in any categories listed below:
 - Unique perspective relating to a *single* highpointing experience.
 - Original ideas regarding exploration, destinations, environmental awareness **or** stewardship.
4. Committee will read de-identified essays and award one scholarship per year.

Funding

The Highpointers Club Treasurer will fund the JPHC Scholarship Program which will be supported in part by the Jack Parsell Memorial Fund and in part by the Highpointers Club Mercantile. This multi-source funding celebrates a founding member of the Highpointers Club, along with encouraging support of our Highpointers Club Mercantile. While the Highpointers Club is a non-profit, we are a C-7 designation so direct donations are not tax deductible. Mercantile purchases will allow donors to receive great product value, knowing that a portion of these proceeds will go directly to the scholarship fund supporting education.

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Application Instructions

Please complete the attached application form to apply for the Scholarship and submit it by **April 30, 2018**. Late applications will not be accepted.

Requirements:

- Must be a family member or extended family member of a Highpointer Club member.
- Must be under the age of 23.
- Must be enrolled in a 2- or 4-year undergraduate program or be accepted for the upcoming fall semester.
- Must have experience in outdoor activities, hiking, travel geography, culture, environmental studies or stewardship.
