John Bryan State Park is about 43 miles south of Bellefontaine near Yellow Springs. It's the most scenic park in western Ohio with a limestone gorge cut by the Little Miami River. A portion of the gorge is a national natural landmark. The park has 6 sites for top-rope climbing and one for rappelling. There are bolt anchors at each site and the free climbs are rated using the Yosemite Decimal Scale and range in difficulty from 5.2 through 5.11.
