This is a konvention for all, from first time attendees to those that haven't missed one yet. It's for those just starting their highpointing journey to those that have done 'em all and everyone in between. There will be plenty of things to see and do for families, kids and individuals not only at the Konvention but around the Logan County area as well.

The Konvention will be held on Ohio's highest point, Campbell Hill, at the Ohio Hi-Point Career Center about 2 miles northeast of downtown Bellefontaine.

The city of Bellefontaine (pronounced bel-FOWN-tin) means "Beautiful Spring" in French. It is the county seat of Logan County with a population of around 13,000 and the highpoint, Campbell, is within its city limits.

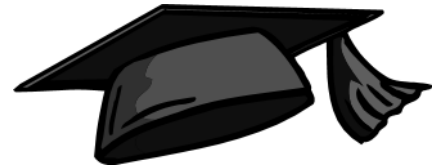
The highpoint was once the former home of the Bellefontaine Air Force Station. The



664th Aircraft Control and Warning Squadron maintained an early warning radar site during the Cold War years. The land was originally deeded to Solomon Rogue in 1830 and later sold in 1898 to Charles D. Campbell in whose name Campbell Hill is currently known.

In lieu of an official host motel, we are excited to announce that we have exclusive use of the Ohio Hi-Point Career Center. Registration and all major events will be coordinated from the Career center grounds. Registration begins on Thursday and as long as the weather cooperates you'll be able to register for the Konvention while standing on the benchmark at the highpoint! How kool is that! Seminars, displays and the Pancake Breakfast will be at the Career Center. The Social will be held at the Ohio Caverns on Friday with an opportunity to tour the caverns. The Annual Banquet will be held on Saturday at the Huntsville Event Center. Both of these events are about a 15 minute drive from the Career Center.
