COURT STREET

'Oldest concrete street in America' is on the south side of the Logan County Courthouse in downtown Bellefontaine. It has retained its original concrete pavement for over one hundred years.

McKinley Street

Only a couple of blocks from the courthouse, its claim is 'The World's Shortest Street' although a street in Scotland makes the same claim.

Ohio Caverns
